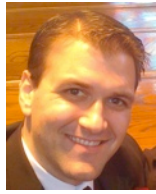


# 6<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL HOLY CROSS CHORAL WORKSHOP SUMMER 2011



## About the Director Mr. Ray Bonnette

After graduating from La Salle University in 2003, Ray Bonnette came to Holy Cross and took over the Choral Program and became the Vocal Director of the Theater program. Over the last 8 years, he has seen the choral program grow from as little as 15 singers when he started, to at most 70 members. Wanting to improve the musicality and technique of his students, and give his students a chance to choose the music they want to sing, he started the Choral Workshop in the summer of 2006 with much success.



## About the Accompanist Cameron Stringham '10

Cameron has been involved in the Choral Workshop for the last 4 years. During his time at Cross, he has accompanied the choir and the spring musicals. Outside of school, he is an active member of St. Charles parish and is also an organist at Our Lady Queen of Peace in Hainesport. He can also be found as a music director at Burlington County Footlighters and Pennsauken Summer Theater. Cameron attends Immaculate University pursuing a degree in music education, concentrating in piano.



## About the Workshop

The Summer Choral Workshop is a great way to learn about the fundamentals in music theory and voice technique, while singing songs that the participants choose. From contemporary to medleys to show tunes, the students learn the music within the week and share what they have learned at the Final Concert. Each day provides a challenge to help our singers become better vocalists and musicians.
